Socio-demographics

These are characteristics of a population such as age, gender, ethnicity, education level, income, years of experience, location, etc.

Functional Competencies

This describes the knowledge and/or abilities required to do a particular job task, duty or responsibilities

Occupation Specific Requirements

Specific competencies required for an opportunity, which can be represented by a certificate or a license

Behaviours for Work

These are the ways a person acts or conducts themselves (especially towards others) which contributes to success in work

Interest in Opportunity

There is an overlap between what the opportunity offers and what the person is willing to accept.

Socialisation for Work

This describes adaptability to the social elements of the working environment
